

We have a family in our church that has been coming for many years. They have a boy in middle school (that I will call Brother E) who is autistic and attends a special school. He has grown up in our church and has heard many Bible stories in Sunday school. He listens to the messages and enjoys the hymns. He writes notes to us along with others in the church and includes scripture verses that he picks out. He tells his father to pray when he forgets to, like before driving the car, etc. Not long ago, I was talking with his parents, and they told me that their son would like to be baptized! It took me by surprise, and I said if he would like to be baptized, he needs to understand what sin is and that he is a sinner. He needs to understand that Jesus died in his place to pay for his sins and understand that Jesus forgives and will give him eternal life in heaven if he believes on Him; they said, he understands that. As I talked with Brother E, he confirmed that he believes in Jesus and has been saved! I said we can schedule a baptismal then at another church that has a baptismal pool or we can go to the river. He wanted to be baptized in the river! Wow... what a blessing and encouragement. We plan to wait until the weather gets warmer.

Over a year ago we met Pastor Tsunematsu who lives a couple of hours away from us near the large city of Kyoto. Over twenty years ago he went to Canada and attended a King James church and their Bible school. He came back to Japan and has been serving as the pastor of a bible believing church ever since. We invited him and his young people for a meeting and youth fellowship. He preached for us and the meeting was a real blessing! He mentioned that they have not had any fellowship with other churches for many years. Finding other conservative Christians (let alone Bible Believers) to fellowship with, in Japan, has always been difficult, especially for young people!
