Years ago, a church helped us with \$1,000 to dig a well, so we hired men to dig until the money ran out, but didn't find water. We

tried to use \$100 a month to keep digging deeper, but after some months the hard slate rock at that level defeated the workers and they quit. Pastor Moti couldn't find any well diggers that would continue the work, leaving me at a loss for a solution.

Recently, the county government brought a water project through our church property. Pastor Moti said they piped water to this tank from a local borehole. In dry weather, Moti has to transport water from a pond two miles away, so this water source is a huge answer to prayer. It's hard to believe the government would solve this problem for us, but we have to give credit where it's due. God moves in peculiar ways.

Pastor Joe Adkins invited us to **Good News Baptist Church** in Churubusco, Indiana. Pastor Joe invited us to a home cooked supper made by Mrs. Adkins, and we enjoyed conversation until bedtime. Before church Sunday morning, the kids kept me entertained with their verbal jousting. Pastor Adkins stuck to the Word during Sunday School and worship service – I like book, chapter and verse! – and gave us the opportunity to share our ministry in Kenya.

Bonus round: The children of the church raised about \$700 to buy Bibles in Kenya. Amazing! The girls beat the boys in the last moments of the competition. Sorry boys. Maybe next year. The exciting news is these American kids are helping Kenyan kids, and even adults, get the Word of God. It's sad when people don't have a Bible to see with their own eyes what is being taught and preached. The girls and boys at **Good News** are problem solvers!
