Dear Praying Friends, one of the greatest encouragements in our ministry continues to be watching the believers in Punta Arenas, Chile, grow in their love for God's Word and their desire to share the gospel.

Many in our church were saved out of Pentecostal backgrounds. As I teach the Scriptures verse by verse, they are learning to compare what they once believed with what the Bible actually says. While these lessons can be challenging, my wife and I are thankful for those who have chosen to stand on the authority of God's Word and continue to grow in their faith.

One blessing has been our church's enthusiasm for street evangelism. Although our congregation averages 12 to 20 people, nearly every member has participated in distributing gospel literature and speaking with people about Christ.

Recently, our church began holding a new street ministry each Saturday evening. With gospel literature, instrumental hymns, and personal conversations, proclaiming Christ to those passing by. We are grateful to report that during these outreach evenings, at least one person has professed faith in Jesus Christ each night. We know that only the Lord can save souls, and we rejoice in seeing Him bless the faithful witness of His people.

One personal encouragement has been the Lord working through relationships within the church. Erica recently brought her husband, Constantine, to one of our services. We were thankful to have him with us, and we ask that you would pray for him as he continues to hear the preaching of God's Word. It is a blessing to see our church members inviting family and friends to church.

At the end of May, we traveled to United States for a brief furlough. We were thankful to attend our son's graduation from Bible college and to visit supporting churches in Texas, Arizona, Oregon, California, Idaho, and Montana. It was a blessing to report on what the Lord is doing in Chile, reconnect with faithful supporters, and spend a short time with family before returning to the field.

Thank you for your faithful prayers and financial support. Your partnership makes it possible for the gospel to continue going forth at the end of the world. Please pray that our church will remain steadfast in the truth, continue reaching the lost, and grow in both number and spiritual maturity.
