Since it was just the three of us there, I spent the entire time witnessing to him. Praise the Lord, he bowed his head and trusted Christ as his Savior. The next Wednesday night we had another first time visitor named Suzana. After the service I was able to deal with her and she admitted that she had never been saved. It was a great joy to see her pray with tears in her eyes and ask the Lord to save her. We greatly enjoyed our time in the States spending time with friends and family. It was bittersweet leaving. Bitter because I hate goodbyes and at the same time sweet because I wanted to get back to our people here. No matter where you go, you don't feel entirely at home because the people you love are spread out in so many different places. When I've described heaven to my son, I've described it as a place where everyone we love is finally together forever and we never have to say goodbye again. I sure do long for that day.


