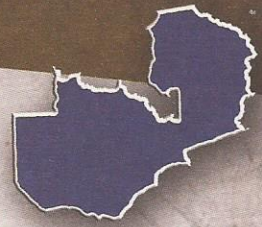

March 2024

The month of March ended with our churches combining for a joint Open Air Preaching event in the Central Business District of Chingola on "Good Friday." More than 30 of our church members attended and helped give out tracts, invite people to church, sing hymns, and preach the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. Seven of our men preached boldly and 3000 Chick Gospel tracts were distributed. My heart was very full by the end of the two hour effort. Please pray with us that the Lord will bring forth much fruit from the seed sown.

A 26-year old young man named Cletus Bwalya goes soul winning with me mostly every Friday morning. He is a breath of fresh air, I'll tell you. I wish everyone could have someone like Cletus in their church. One particular Friday, we crossed paths with a Pentecostal lady named Harriett Nakawala. She gave us the typical "salvation-by-good-works" testimony that we hear from the Pentecostal members. But as we explained the Gospel to her in its simplicity of trusting in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross, you could see understanding come over her. Her countenance began to change and she began to get very excited. I told Cletus, "It was almost like you could 'see' her getting saved." She prayed in simple faith to receive the Lord. I don't know if I have ever seen someone's faith so visible on their face. Amen.

Our power company, Zesco, has started load-shedding from 8 hours a day to 12 hours a day. It is a long time to be without power each day and they say this will last for one year. They say that it is due to the drought in this area causing the hydroelectric schemes not to have enough water to produce electricity. But they also sell off a lot of the power we produce here to other countries. Hallelujah! For this cause, we installed some small solar panel lighting systems in the church building where we have Bible institute classes at night. We also installed them in our three pastors' houses. We have a great solar system and generator at our own house and we didn't want our leaders being in the dark for hours each night. Thank you for your sacrificial giving that makes these things possible. We would be in the dark without you! Amen!
