After an extended but very fruitful stay in the US I am now back in Cambodia to resume my labor in the vineyard God has blessed me with. My brother Piseth, who is the Regional Director in southeast Asia for Samaritan's Purse, was happy to see me come back home. We have 20,000 shoeboxes to distribute to the kids in the Tonle Sap Lake region! I will visit all 18 of our church plants as well and resume the discipleship classes for the pastors and the men who are seeking to pastor a church.

My trip to the US was such a blessing. Siela's uncle and aunt who live in Seattle graciously provided me with a car to drive during my stay. I was able to present our ministry to several churches in South Dakota, Ohio, Colorado, and Texas. I also received an invitation to a Missions Conference at Bible Believers Baptist Church in Corpus Christi, Texas (Bevans Welder is the pastor). Through these churches God has provided financial and prayer support. It was a wonderful opportunity to meet missionaries from other countries and to hear some great preaching as well!




BBBC Missions Conference





Two older kids from the Children's Home, Mengleng and Visal, earned scholarships to study in the US. When I brought them over from Cambodia in October I had to drive them from Seattle to Fredonia, New York to start classes. I pursued the possibility of transferring the scholarship over to the University of Washington so the kids could be close to Siela's aunt and uncle and by God's grace we were able to do that. Visal is studying to be a Mechanical Engineer and Mengleng to become a registered nurse. This is a huge blessing and another answer to prayer! As the kids in the Children's Home grow up to be adults we are encouraged to see them go into the ministry or seek a trade or degree so they are able to contribute to the adoption and raising of more orphans and street kids. They know how much God has blessed them and this part of our ministry.

As we see the monsoon season approaching we will continue to provide people out in the province churches with water filters, medicine, and food as we are able. Some of the COVID restrictions are still in place making it very difficult to find jobs. So many have died from starvation during this time. Your continued prayer and financial support are so much appreciated as we see many people come to the Savior even through all the suffering.







The churches in the provinces are growing. Pastor Hai recently led an entire family to the Lord. Praise God for the faithfulness of the pastors.





We continue to be grateful for your dedicated support and prayers for our ministries here. We still see the Gospel working in the hearts of people who have never heard it and sat so long in darkness.
