



The Demopoulos Family Missionaries to Ukraine August, 2022



While in northwestern Indiana we would go out every Saturday and preach and soul win. The Lord gave me a great opportunity to deal with a group of 18–20-year-olds. The Lord gave a lot of liberty to deal with them for a good 20 minutes about sin, death, heaven and hell and a personal testimony. I left them with tracts. After almost 40 years of dealing with sinners publically it is still a great blessing to serve the Lord in this way. We are *still* seeing people making a profession of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ out on the streets.

Move to Pensacola – Since the last time we were back in the States on furlough prices have shot up drastically. Our car cost almost twice as much. Renting is ‘out of sight’ but we thank the Lord for giving us a good place to stay with our son-in-law, and our daughter in Pensacola who is soon expecting a child at the end of August. Please pray for that. I’ll be a grandpa again waiting for another “son” *i.e.*, another grandson.



Staying busy – While we wait for Galia’s green card we are staying busy, staying in touch with many of our members from a few different churches; preaching each Wednesday and Sunday morning by “zoom.” If we did not have this modern technology, I’m sure some of our men would still get out and witness, preach the gospel, pass out tracts and soul win. One of the men God has given us is Sasha. He’s a workhorse, like others that God has given us that have been trained at the Institute or with whom we’ve laboured together. The last time we had Bible Institute, in January we had well over 15 preachers; pastors, evangelists, and a future missionary, that God gave us before the bombs starting falling in Kiev, let alone in other places throughout Ukraine. Please pray for their safety and for more opportunities for them to witness.

Printing – Concerning the printing ministry, we were able to print **20,000** tracts of “**And What After Death**” in the Ukrainian language in Kiev. Also, we have now available our **Second Edition** of the Ukrainian translation of the **King James Bible**, New Testament and the 5 wisdom books. These are also being sent out to various places in Ukraine. We thank the Lord for Pastor Gervin Walls and Mt Pisgah Baptist Church, Oliver Springs, Tennessee for helping us with these printing projects; **Johns and Romans** and the **New Testament** in the Ukrainian tongue. So now we’ve got two places where we are printing material; in Kiev, and also in Tennessee. We are supplying Russian and Ukrainian-speaking people with Christian literature here in the States and abroad in Europe. Please pray for the shipping of this material to various parts of Ukraine. We are shipping by orders of those that are King James Bible people and not ‘TR’ or Alexandrian. It has taken many years for God to give us this kind of fellowship. After years of translation work in both Russian and Ukrainian languages with all the corrupt ‘bibles’ that are *still* coming out to this very day, God has given us a whole fellowship of Slavic people that want truth just like any English-speaking Bible believer. I simply took it for granted that when I read “**Where the word of a king is, there is power: and who may say unto him, What doest thou?** (Eccl. 8:4)” that, as a missionary,

like the apostle Paul, who said, “**we are not as many which corrupt the word of God**” (2 Cor. 2:17) that the best approach to this whole ordeal of translation work, is, that the King’s Book ought to be translated. PERIOD! That picture is so beautifully laid out in the Old Testament: One King gives a decree and that decree would be translated into the various languages in his kingdom. So that’s what we did; One King, one Book from which to translate. God has really blessed our efforts! We wrote a book called, “**Translating the King James Bible into a Foreign Language by a ‘Decree’ of a King for all nations.**” If you’d like to read it just let us know.

A new work on the back burner, Lord willing! – A national friend of ours, Boris from the western part of Ukraine hopes that we will come and help get another work started, based on the Ukrainian translation of the King James Bible. That will be a first for us. *So, please put some prayer on that.* If and when the war stops for the most part and we’re in good conscience to get back to Ukraine, (which was target no. 1 for Putin) we hope to pick up where we left off – preaching the Gospel, training *men*, and planting churches. Brother Boris is going around to different pastors in his area and showing them the differences between the other Ukrainian texts that are shot through with corruption and the Ukrainian text of the King James Bible. He has dealt with a few pastors already. One pastor of a church of over 500 members has now switched to the Ukrainian KJV text. Boris is working on others pastors now and letting as many know about this text. “**Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified...**” (2 Thess. 3:1) and “**charity...rejoiceth in the TRUTH.**”
