Dear Pastor and Church, dear praying friends!

March and April were great months for us; praise the Lord. In March at our evangelistic thrust on Nuremberg and Fuerth we distributed 15.000+ tracts and church invitations in various areas of the city. Not only did we pass out tracts, but we also preached on the streets and always drew some people that listened to the preaching. We experienced the usual responses: some were listening attentive, others laughed at us and scorned us, others got mad. We had nonetheless good conversations about the Lord and challenged quite a few people to get saved. God blessed this effort and we saw at one time **7 first time visitors at church**. Some said they were already saved, others wanted to check us out, and two Turkish sisters (siblings) actually were seeking a church (but they had expectations that we were not able to meet, and I don't think they will come back). May the Lord bless all the spiritual seed that was sown, whether by the printed word or personal conversations, to his honour and glory.

Mid March, we saw **Uli** come as a visitor to Church (Uli is 63 years old); at her second visit she received the Lord Jesus as her saviour. **Martin** had been following our live stream Church services on the internet for about four months, then he came for the first time to the men's prayer breakfast, and I led him to the Lord. He is in his mid-50s. Since then, he comes to Church on Sunday quite regularly. Patrick led his neighbour **Matthias** to the Lord; he is in his late 30s. On Easter Sunday two men came to Church for the first time, Stephen and David. Stephen got assurance of his salvation and **David** did get saved that Sunday right after the Church service. David is in his mid-20s. **PRAISE THE LORD**.

Please pray for these newly saved to »grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.« 2.Peter 3:18. I will offer a new convert class to them in May and hopefully we will see them baptized in July. Tamara, the high school girl that got saved earlier, wants also to be baptized. There were more souls saved in the last couple of weeks, but they were in the greater personal realm of our people, some as far away as Uganda and Scotland.

It is such a blessing to see our folks having a heart for the lost and actively 'reaching out' to anyone who is willing to listen, whether here in our town, or to their friends and acquaintances abroad.

We do have some people ill at church and Sister Kerstin and Brother Willi sure would appreciate your prayers for them.

My wife Sabine and I are doing well; all things considered. The pending situation with the government agency is still, well, pending. Hopefully this will be resolved soon.
