Dear Pastor and Church, dear praying friends!

First of all, let me say 'Thank you!' to all those that reached out to me after my last prayer letter with uplifting and encouraging words and messages. It is very much appreciated. It seems like the spiritual drought continues, yet the Lord is sending refreshing rain showers along the way. Here are some of them:

A man, Lars his name, contacted us with a lot of questions on his mind. He claims to be saved and his testimony is solid. He lives 250 miles away from us in the City of Magdeburg. I started to disciple him after a few phone calls, he is enrolled in our new convert course, and we speak on the phone regularly and have weekly ZOOM meetings. He says over and over again how thankful he is to God for bringing us into his life. He says we straighten out his thoughts and believes and align them with the Bible. He never experienced such a thing. He was very much confused about a lot of spiritual and doctrinal issues but is starting now to see things clearly. One of the first things we talked about is dispensationalism and how this is the key to understanding the Bible. Just last Saturday we drove up to Magdeburg and visited with him. There is much potential for a future Bible Study that might eventually grow into an independent Church. Lars is very open, teachable and understands what is right and wrong when shown from the Bible. Please pray for him and our working with him.

Lars has an acquaintance; her name is Alexandra. She lives about 130 miles away from him. He forwarded her to us also. Alexandra might be described with the Bible verse of Romans 10:2 » For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.« In our first conversation I very thoroughly explained to her what it means to rely on Christ's sacrificial death for our salvation. She had never done that, but she did right then. I really believe she got saved that day. I also have her enrolled in our new convert course and have regular phone calls and ZOOM meetings with her. She also testifies how much her thinking has changed, how much understanding she has gained and how her thinking is being straightened out by our conversations. She even is considering moving to our area for the lack of a solid Bible believing Church around her.

We are finally able to start a Bible group in one of the local nursing homes. I already visit there regularly and am part of the nursing home advisory council. Our first meeting is scheduled for July 22nd. I even had some residents approach me about the Bible verse on the bike basket I am carrying with me and they are excited about the upcoming Bible group.

Our ministry here in Fuerth continues as usual with our Church life and activities, yet with the mentioned spiritual "drought". We are praying for some constant and much needed rain.

May the Lord bless you in these days and thank you for your prayers and faithful support.
