Trip to Ukraine – Lord willing we are planning a trip for September. Please pray for the following: Organizing a Bible conference. We hope to start a small Bible Institute using our lessons; our evangelization, tracting, and soulwinning efforts, and doing that yet in another city. We are in need of about \$4000 for this "Ukraine trip;" tickets, diesel, hotels, food, etc. (left) Lord willing, this is what we look forward to, the tremendous opportunity to sow the seed of the word of God. **Behold, a sower went forth to sow;** (Matt. 13:3). Last time we saw folks get saved. A church was started. A preacher was ordained, etc.



(left) **Hot off the press. July 24, 2026, is when we got our first copy of the entire translation of the Ukrainian Bible translated from the King James text.** Hopefully, with the Lord's help, we'll be able to start sending these out; either from Ukraine and also from the States. We have been working with a national, (Boris) who knows both Russian and Ukrainian languages. Brother David Lohman has put a lot of effort into this text also and has organized for this translation to get on a container headed for Ukraine.

(right) **Brother Sasha Dolbin** (second from left) has been a long-time missionary sent out of our church. He's one of the first that we laid hands on. We recently got news that he has stage 4 cancer. He's been a hard-working servant of the Lord.



Please pray the Lord takes those cancerous cells from his body and strengthens him to continue to labour for our Lord and Saviour. We started a couple of churches from tent meetings with him years ago. He lives in the village of Kashperovka, (**pop. 4,000**), just 3 hours south of Kyiv. He was being supported by the Baptist Union in Ukraine, until he began believing in Eternal Security and moved his membership to our church. Our church took him on! As we've mentioned before, 99% of the Baptist Union teaches that if you believe in Eternal Security, you are a Calvinist. It's a mess! We thank the Lord for our friendship with brother Sasha and his family over the years.

Health – It's been a year since I started some kind of exercises on my own for hip arthritis, but now I'm going through a more detailed course. Please pray that the muscles around the hips and core muscles will be strengthened so that my health will improve for more mobility.



More fruit along the way While at an intersection a young man, Jasiah stopped his car and came up to me requesting prayer. He is young in the Lord and asked several Bible questions. That was an answer to prayer because just a few months before this, I started praying specifically that people would pull over to seek help. The Lord came through.

While at another street corner preaching, two different men at two different times also stopped. Both insisted I take their 'freewill offering.' Well, because of that I had a couple of good meals that day.

Correspondence students - Another student finished the **Correspondence of the Theological Studies**. Brother Vlad, from Russia, one of our men that came to Kyiv several times for Institute classes recently finished the Correspondence Course of the Theological Studies. We *retranslated* all of them. Plus, the verses are from the Russian translation of the King James Bible. We also added 10 questions for each subject. It comes to about 680 questions for the entire course. We are still getting students that are interested in studying the word of God with us either by correspondence or national pastors are taking some of their own members and going through each lesson. **2 Timothy 2:2**. We are thankful for their faithfulness. The Lord has given us Russian students in the United States that are **in jails** that are studying with us. The Lord has added a special blessing to this by giving us a good number of students from a few different churches in the United States that are going through the lessons with their pastors. At present our students are in Ukraine, Kazakhstan and the U.S. **Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, (Eph. 3:20) God is good!**

This is Alex, only 20 years old. He is from Moscow. God has given us the opportunity to deal with many Russians, of which most are from either St. Petersburg or from Moscow.

(right) **Alexi**, is from Kalingrad, (pop. 489,359)

which is located between Lithuania and Poland. Alexi is third to the captain on a ship from Oslo, Norway. I dealt with him in his own language. These are modern-day "**Magog-ites.**"



On another ship the Lord gave us about 20 minutes to witness to two men from India. Within an hour the Lord gave us these men to witness to; four different men from two different countries. What a blessing!

Meetings We've had meetings in Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia and Florida presenting "**the work**" in Ukraine and Former Soviet Union.

We sure do appreciate all of your prayers and support. They mean much to us.
