The Lord has just brought us through one of the busiest seasons of ministry that we have experienced here in Scotland, and we are very grateful for it! We have seen growth and new attenders in almost every area and department of our church. Please allow me to give you a brief summary of some of the great things that the Lord has done:

Adventurers (Elementary age children)

Our Adventurers Bible Club has grown every year since we began our ministry at Hopeman Baptist Church. However, over the last year the Lord has brought so many new children, we have had to split them into 2 separate sessions! In fact, our Thursday night children's ministry has become so popular that we recently received a message that we never expected. The Parent Council of our local elementary school reached out to say that they were not going to schedule their regular school extra-curricular activities on a Thursday night, because they did not want to "compete" with what we were doing at the church! This is because roughly a third of their student body comes to our church every Thursday evening to learn about how much Jesus loves them.

Explorers (High School age students)

A missing link in our ministries that we addressed this year, was to have something for these elementary age students when they begin High School. In Scotland there is no "Junior High," so when you finish sixth grade you start High School. This is when most Scots really begin to disconnect from the idea of church. However, we have seen steady growth since we began our Explorers ministry for High Schoolers, with a high of 22! For the majority of these teenagers, this is the first time that they have ever attended a church, but they are making the choice for themselves to come.
