In the Meantime

While we wait patiently to get back to Ukraine, we are staying busy talking to many of our folks – those of our church in

Kiev and others who have joined us that are located in various countries; America, Spain, Poland, Ukraine, Russia, and Kazakhstan.

Please pray that Ukrainians especially won't get discouraged as the war drags on, and that they won't get out of fellowship with the Lord.

The last thing we heard is that in Kiev they are digging trenches at one of the main entrances into the city. That main entrance is but 3 miles from our home. Our house is located only 2 blocks from an alternate entrance into the city.

Correspondence

The Lord has given us 3 men that are now directing the Bible Correspondence courses using our lessons. One of the men is in Ukraine, another in Russia and the third in Pridnestrovie.

We've recently had an increase in students. One of our men, Oleg, a member of the church in Kiev, decided to take the Correspondence Course of the Theological Studies. That is a course of the Theological Studies by the late Dr. Peter S. Ruckman. We translated 10 questions for each lesson. It is a blessing to see different Slavic folk who take these lessons and finish the course. Upon finishing they receive a Certificate of Completion.

Please pray that the Lord will continue to supply us with more students.

God has given us another man, Eugene that had completed the Correspondence Course for Bible Believers. He did that while serving as a missionary in Altai, (southern Siberia). Since then, he has been forced to leave the country of Russia. He is now in Transnistria. The Russian name is Pridnestrovie, a strip of land between Ukraine and Moldova. He's asked for all 48 lessons to start teaching others God has given him to teach. This is what we're looking for, men that will carry on the job of 2 Timothy 2:2, **And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.**

Witnessing to Seafaring men

I've had more opportunities to deal with seafaring men within the last two months. (Right), On a cargo ship, I dealt with a Ukrainian, Andrei. He is the captain of this ship. He invited me to have lunch with him. The cook made a Ukrainian soup called Borsch, a well-known national soup ready and prepared for us to eat. I gave Andrei our Ukrainian New Testament and a John and Romans booklet. He was told how to go through the verses that explain salvation. I gave my personal testimony as to how I was a former Orthodox and came to know the Lord Jesus Christ. It was a real blessing to talk with Andrei.



Please pray that he will get saved along with many other Russians and Ukrainians I've had the opportunity to witness to.

Have wheels will travel! I would like to thank the churches that helped me get a car so that I can travel and take meetings without having to rent cars all the time. Sure do appreciate this blessing!

6th Edition of the Russian Translation of the King James Bible

We rejoice in the fact that we finally found a place where we can get our sixth edition of the Russian translation of the King James Bible printed. This time we'll be printing 2,000 Bibles, leather-bound, gold edges, maps, introduction before the Old and New Testaments, a plan of salvation at the end of the Bible, and other features. There are a number of people in various countries that have enquired about this text.

Please pray that we won't have to wait very long to get this next batch and that we'll be able to get these sent out to the various countries.

Concerning material that is being sent out, within the last two months, my son in law, David Lohman has sent out 20 boxes of the Ukrainian New Testaments. That's almost a 1000 New Testaments shipped. Concerning Johns and Roman in Ukrainian we've sent out 14 boxes of 260 copies each. That's almost 3,700 copies of John's and Romans going to various places to people that will pass those out for evangelization. We have continued to do this for close to 30 years. Gogites and Magogites will have no excuse, especially with the proper text with revelation that is not found in the other translations in either Russian or Ukraine. It was Jesus Christ that said, **"I have given them thy word;"** (Jn. 17:14).

Concerning the Ukrainian text, we are still in the process of cleaning it up for our third edition. Recently, we hit a milestone. One of our men in western Ukraine learned how to use a computer program to help very easily and effectively polish up the text finding like words from cover to cover according to First Corinthians 2:13, **"comparing spiritual things with spiritual things."** That helps us eliminate a very tedious aspect in the process of Bible translation and lining it up as much as possible to the King James text.

Below are three more men of many hundreds of people that continue to receive Johns and Romans and the New Testament in Ukrainian.



The man on the far right, **Petro**, is a deacon of a traditional Baptist Church in western Ukraine. He favors our Ukrainian text. His church is looking for a pastor, a national. One of our men with whom we have been working for the last few years is going to be

andidating for that church. He is a Bible believer. I've given him instructions as to how to start with these people. You know the drill. They know a lot about 'life' persay but know very little Bible.

Please put some prayer on this brother, Boris and also on the pastor; that Boris will get the 'nod' to feed those dear people the word of God, if that be the Lord's will.
