Dear Brethren,

May-June 2026

Thanks so much for your prayers in regard to this ministry to the people of Bangladesh. The country has a new government and we pray that there would be greater freedom to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ. That's a whopping big prayer for this part of the world but our God is able and His word does not return void. We have seen souls saved and the attendance at many of the house churches has increased. So, we press on by His grace and power.

“And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews...” John 19:38a

Brother Halal was a Sufi Muslim who became a believer on Christ. He is actually one of four Christians that I have met that were driven completely from their homes. Some have told me that the ‘Sufi’ are considered the polar opposite of the hardline Islamists within the Muslim religion. A form of asceticism. Halal had been listening to Christian radio broadcasts and prayed to God that his soul would be saved. By God’s providence he came into contact with brother Biduut who prayed with him and gave him a bible and other material. After about a year Biduut kind of lost contact with him but we decided to go to his area and find him. His story is amazing and his Heavenly Father is taking good care of him. After being driven out of his home, village, and livelihood, he landed in Dhaka and is running a teashop with his wife and two children. The entire family is saved and he periodically goes out to pass out tracts and talk with people. A lot of plowing and seed sown but despite no fruit he is undistracted in his witness for Christ. He began to tell us about the two dozen Christians who he was meeting with before his departure from the village. They prayed with him and they truly believed but since leaving there was no one to read the scripture to them. The literacy rate outside Dhaka is about 70% and many just can’t read. Halal calls them ‘secret Christians’ for his lack of a better term. Babes in Christ having only believed for a matter of months before Halal and family were driven out. They live in fear and Halal wants to make trips in and out of his prior village to help them overcome their fear and help establish their faith. We decided to take this faithful man on for support to reach the Sufi people. I’m sure he would appreciate your prayers.

I had a great meeting with a Garo tribe Baptist church that invited me in to teach for a couple hours. It lasted seven ! There is a hunger for the word of God here and that’s a great encouragement to me as I meet, teach, preach, and at times weep together with them. Thank you for being a big part of all of this and may our Lord bless you for it.
