Dear Brethren, I hope you all had a wonderful Christmas and New Year. As Americans, we have been blessed beyond measure with the freedoms and liberties we enjoy, and they are continually under attack. Often, it is not until we travel and get exposed to other lands and cultures that we fully appreciate just how fortunate we are. Recently, I was invited by a brother in Christ to teach in his home for a few days. We had about a dozen folks turn out, and the Lord was really moving upon some hearts in this very strict Islamic section of the city. This dear brother left his apartment on the seventh floor and went to the market to get some things for lunch. On his way back, the security guards told him they wanted me, the foreign Christian guy, to leave. He politely told them I'd be there for a few days, and he just ignored them. Security then shut off the elevator, so he had to walk up the seven floors. He was pretty shaken up, but we all prayed, and we finally heard from the homeowner's association that all was okay. Oftentimes, the opposition is not because of what we do but because of who we are, the Body of Christ.



We are praying that the upcoming election on February thirteenth will go smoothly. No matter who wins, there will be some who aren't happy. Except for the Hill Tracts area, my movement within Bangladesh has been unrestricted, and I pray it stays that way. After the election, we have the opportunity to preach and teach in a large Hindu area just outside of Dhaka. There is also a longstanding Catholic presence there. I was introduced to a man named 'Clinton Mondol' whose family history involves a transition to Catholicism two generations ago, with their heritage rooted in Hinduism. Clinton received Christ and has been a bold witness to other family members. Bro. Robin has been doing some discipleship with them. We have five men who want to go into this area, desiring to plant a Baptist Church. To God be the glory.



Bro. Bejoy continues to minister to the college-aged students as he grows in the knowledge of the Lord. Bro. Biduut and I recently met at the home of a cab driver, whom Biduut led to Christ. Bro. Robin is presently in the Hill Tracts distributing blankets to some villagers. And God gave me the opportunity and privilege to preach to about thirty men who get together from different areas for their Men's Christian Fellowship. May the Lord pour out His blessings upon you in the upcoming year 2026.
