Greetings from Mexico! We pray that this letter finds you all doing well. The month of May is our missions month. We had both missions conferences just a week apart from each other. The theme for this year was "Time Is Running Out". During the conference, we had a death counter that mark the number of people that were dying. At the end of the four day meeting, the counter was a little over a half million souls who had gone out into eternity....a sobering thought. The Lord blessed, and our faith promise commitment went up in both churches allowing us to take on several more missionaries. There is still so much to do, and time is running out. Are we doing what we can to make a difference today?

The past six weeks has also brought some difficult circumstances. One of the faithful young men in our church in Tequix was in a terrible automobile accident last month and not given much hope for survival. However, God in His mercy has allowed him to live, and three weeks later he took his first couple of steps. He still has a long road to recovery, but it has been amazing to witness the miracle that God has done in Giovanni's life. His immediate family is not saved; please help us pray that through this trial they can see their need for salvation.

The summer is always busy for us with camps and VBS. This year is going to be challenging as the school system is only planning on giving the students one to two weeks off for vacation. Please help us pray for the upcoming events. For years, we have had Bible Institute classes two nights a week, but I feel as though the Lord would have us go full time in September. We are excited about the group of young people that want to serve the Lord.

Have you ever wondered what kind of difference your life is making? Then you are unexpectedly blessed with a kind note or someone that just says "Thank you" for the investment you have made. I had two such occasions this past week. The church here supports a Christian men's rehab center in S.L.P. While out preaching a meeting, a young man came up to me and thanked me for our support of the rehab over the years. He had gone through the rehab center, gotten saved, was called to preach, and is now in his first year of Bible college. Only eternity will tell exactly the hearts and lives that have been touched through your sacrificial giving and prayers. You are making a difference, and we want to thank you for your continued prayer and support. May the Lord bless you.
