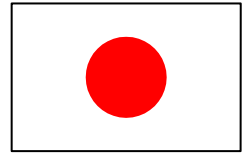

We had a busy summer and saw the Lord's blessings in many ways. Thank you for your prayers! In July we had a visitor from the States, Rosetta, who came to Japan for 5 weeks. She was able to give her testimony on separate occasions, teach our children in Sunday school, and play the piano for our services. She also had the opportunity to meet other Christians in two other churches and helped us with the planning and music at our church summer camp in August. She was a big help and encouragement to our church and other young people. Please pray for God's continued guidance and direction in her life.

We had a baptismal at the Yahagi River not far from our church. The Lord gave us good weather and so we held our Sunday morning services on the bank of the river. Ezekiel (15) had been looking forward to getting baptized and it was a joyous occasion for him and his parents. We also had a young man Kenichi (23) get baptized, and we praise the Lord for his goodness! Please pray that these two individuals will grow in the Lord and stay faithful to Him.

We were able to visit an elderly lady named Mrs. Futo. We have known her for about ten years, but she moved away and we have not seen her for many years. She keeps in contact with a couple of Christian ladies we know, however, she is not saved. A Christian lady, Lynn, has been trying to be a witness to her for many years. Mrs. Futo has a Buddhist altar in her home and still sees Buddhism as the Japanese way. Please pray for the Lord to open her eyes to the truth of the gospel.

Mrs. Ohta, our elderly neighbor, brought her friend, Yoshiko, over to our house and Rosetta played the piano for them and we enjoyed singing some songs. These ladies were involved with choir and have played musical instruments for many

In August we had our church summer camp. It was three days long this year and we invited people from Biwako Baptist Bible Church in Ohtsu city, a couple of hours away. We had 29 people attend and enjoyed good preaching, a barbeque, games, and an encouraging time of fellowship. Many of our young people were encouraged in their Christian life. At camp we also had several people give testimonies and others gave a brief summary of a missionary story they read about. Some of the missionary stories were about those who faced trials in Japan and others in China. Overall, the Holy Spirit moved through the preaching and testimonies as some gave testimonies later of what the Lord spoke to them about or how they were encouraged. Keep praying for some of our young people who need salvation.
